### OHIO HONORARY MEMBER AWARD

Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America (Ohio FCCLA) honors people whose professional responsibilities are not directly related to Ohio FCCLA, who have made outstanding contributions and who are giving continued service to the state organization.

Focusing on the multiple roles of family member, wage earner, and community leader, members develop skills for life through: character development, creative and critical thinking, interpersonal communication, practical knowledge, and career preparation.

The Purpose of Ohio FCCLA is:

- To provide opportunities for personal development and preparation for adult life
- To strengthen the function of the family as a basic unit of society
- To encourage democracy through cooperative action in the home and community
- To encourage individual and group involvement in helping achieve global cooperation and harmony
- To promote a greater understanding between youth and adults
- To provide opportunities for making decisions and for assuming responsibilities
- To prepare for multiple roles of men and women today in society
- To promote Family and Consumer Sciences, and related occupations

#### CRITERIA:

Nominees will be recognized for their service to Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America, based on the criteria below. Ohio FCCLA will award up to two nominees for this award. An evaluation committee will be comprised of State Staff.

Evaluations will be based on the following:

- Outstanding and continuing services that contribute to the achievement of Ohio Family, Career and Community Leaders of America mission and purpose
- An effective public relations effort that promotes Ohio Family, Career and Community Leaders of America statewide
- Assistance in developing or carrying out Ohio Family, Career and Community Leaders of America projects statewide
- Leadership positions held within the organization
- Two (2) letters of recommendation

#### OFFICIAL RULES:

- Nominations may be submitted by any Ohio affiliated FCCLA Chapter, current Regional or State Executive Council Member, current Ohio Family, Career and Community Leaders of America Board of Directors or FCCLA StateStaff.
- Nominees may be a past or current chapter or state adviser, part of the state administration, local supervisors of Family and Consumer Sciences teacher educators or business/industry partners.
