



OUTSTANDING CHAPTER AWARD

OUTSTANDING CHAPTER AWARD is presented by a team (up to 3 members) and awarded to chapters who develop and implement a well-balanced program of work that is strategically aligned with state and national Family, Career and Community leaders of America (FCCLA) programming. Activities should reflect instruction that currently take place in the entire family and consumer sciences or related career field program, including classroom instruction, laboratory instruction, individualized instruction in leadership and supervised experiential experiences. Chapters must attend State Leadership Conference to receive this award.

TIME REQUIREMENT: 15 minutes

RULES:

1. This is a chapter event which is registered during Career Development Event registration
2. Timeline for activities is March 1 – March 1
3. Provide evidence of competition of events and activities
4. Official FCCLA Notebook or Ohio FCCLA Power Point template
5. To be awarded the Outstanding Chapter team must receive a 90 or above

CHAPTER OPERATIONS

1. All students in the FCS or related career field program have the opportunity to be a member of FCCLA
2. Members develop and implement a yearlong Program of Work
3. FCCLA chapter constitution and bylaws are up-to-date and approved by the chapter
4. FCCLA chapter conducts regularly scheduled chapter meetings (agendas and minutes)
5. Develop chapter resources (monies, fundraisers, donations)

1. Implement educational/service related projects for a National Programs
 - a. Career Connections
 - b. Student Body
 - c. Financial Fitness
 - d. STOP the Violence
 - e. Families Acting for Community Traffic Safety (FACTS)

2. Participate in State Project – Lead4Change and/or Ohio School Breakfast Challenge
3. Submit application for State Project and/or National Programs Award
4. Implement activities for National Family and Consumer Sciences Day
5. Create a philanthropic awareness/support for Ohio FCCLA Endowment



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SERVICE LEARNING

1. Develop and implement a service learning project
2. Develop and implement a FACTS grant activity
3. Develop and implement Ohio School Breakfast Challenge activity
4. Track and submit Service Learning hours
5. Submit a State and/or National Programs Award application

MEMBER LEADERSHIP

1. Capable and trained officers lead the FCCLA Chapter
2. Members are engaged in leadership projects and activities that strength the program of work
3. Members are engaged in competitive projects and activities that strength the program of work
4. Members are engaged in cooperative projects and activities that strength the program of work
5. Members are engaged in individual projects and activities that strength the program of work
