OUTSTANDING CHAPTER AWARD is presented by a team (up to three members) and awarded to chapters who develop and implement a well-balanced program of work that is strategically aligned with state and national Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) programming.

FCCLA is designed to be a part of your everyday Family and Consumer Sciences and related career fields curriculum through classroom instruction, lab instruction and individualized instruction in leadership and supervised experiential learning. Members can explore career opportunities and build real work-world skills by engaging in developing projects and participating in competitive events and Service-Learning projects.

Prerequisites:

1. All students in FCS or related career field program have the opportunity to be a member of FCCLA
2. Timeline for activities is March 1 – March 1
3. Provide evidence for all criteria implemented
4. Official Ohio FCCLA PowerPoint template
5. Chapters who earn this award must be present at the State Leadership Conference
