Student Conduct of Practices and Procedures

The Ohio FCCLA Board of Directors requires each student to read and complete Practices and Procedures Form as part of the attendance requirements for Fall Leadership Training.

- There shall be no defacing of public or private property. Any damage to any property or furnishings at Heartland Conference Center must be paid for by the individual or chapter.
- Students shall always wear Fall Leadership Training name tag.
- Students shall refrain from verbal, physical, or sexual harassment, hazing, or name-calling.
- Students shall respect the rights and safety of Heartland Staff and Executive Council and State Staff.
- Use of tobacco and vaping products by students is prohibited at all Ohio FCCLA functions.
- Students should be prompt and prepared for all activities.
- Students are required to attend all sessions and activities.
- At 11:00 P.M. begins Quiet Time. During that time, all students are required to be in their rooms and respectful of adult advisers/chaperones in the assigned area.
- FCCLA chapters will be responsible for their students' conduct.

Students who ignore or violate any of the previous rules as outlined by Ohio FCCLA will be subject to disciplinary action, including, but not limited to, being sent home immediately at students' expense.
